Chamber of Mines posts election guides for NWT candidates

- Information for Candidates in the 2019 NWT Election provides detail on 7 focus areas including:
 - o access to land
 - o infrastructure deficit
 - high costs
 - regulatory costs and delays
 - o Indigenous governments' expectations and demands
 - o public awareness; and
 - recommendation to launch a visionary investment confidence strategy

We are hopeful candidates will take advantage of our guides to help them build an economic plan to strengthen the minerals industry and in so doing, the entire NWT economy.
