Nunavut Mining Week 2025 is being celebrated across the territory through a series of engaging virtual contests and educational activities that highlight the importance of mining to Nunavut's communities, culture, and economy.

The **virtual edition** complements in-person events held in mid-September, extending the celebration into classrooms, homes, and communities across the territory.
