

Northern Canada Mineral Exploration September 2019










• Since 2007, NWT missed more than **\$1.4 billion** in exploration investment compared to Nunavut and Yukon



All territories and Canada are now decreasing


Northern Canada Mineral Exploration (with Canada)



 Raising investment dollars has become increasingly difficult in the past 4 years for all jurisdictions.




NWT Exploration Share



• The NWT is projected to continue capturing an even lower share of Canadian exploration investment in 2018.




Nunavut Exploration Share



 Nunavut's share of Canadian exploration investment has been decreasing in recent years.




Nunavut & NWT Exploration Share

- Nunavut share has been falling for 3 years, with slight increase projected.




Nunavut & NWT Exploration Share



• The data suggests a positive effect with release of the NWT Mineral Development Strategy, however it has not been sustained.




NWT – Senior vs Junior Exploration

- Junior companies dominate NWT spending




Nunavut – Senior vs Junior Exploration

- Senior company spending has dominated in Nunavut but share is falling.




NWT Exploration vs Deposit Appraisal 2008-2019




Nunavut Exploration vs Deposit Appraisal 2008-2019








