Royalty Review

- ITI summarized highlights of the content presented during this year's Arctic Energy and Resources Symposium in Calgary
- ITI also spoke briefly of engagement with advanced projects in the NWT to discuss their views and opinions of the current royalty framework, noting that not all projects have the same experience with royalties in the territory
- ITI also noted that it is looking to try and find a global approach to royalties when it comes to critical minerals and rare earth elements, as the royalty framework for these minerals will be more complex than when dealing with rough diamonds.

MRA Regulations
