




ML-8 KIMBERLITE – GOOD MANTLE SAMPLE





ML-8 MICRODIAMOND RESULTS

ML-8 kimberlite SPTUI* vs Naujaat (Q1-4)









- Planning underway for July 2018 drilling.





Pit overlay is for demonstration purposes; conceptual in nature.

- Deposit evaluation function of jurisdiction, location, infrastructure, tonnage, mining method, 'in situ' value etc.
- 'In Situ' Value function of grade and diamond value
- Diamond value function of diamond quality and size distribution
- 2017: confirmed i) Q1-4 tonnage (drilling) & ii) potential diamond value upside (bulk sample)

Internal desk top study of potential mining scenarios suggests extending Q1-4 resource from 200m to 300m below surface would represent the 'sweet spot' for deposit size with open pit strip ratio less than 3:1.








- Hole 17Q-003 also ended in kimberlite below and outside of the current model













- A28 (2014) & A88 (2017) volcaniclastic phases similar proportions of yellow diamonds

Q1-4 DIAMOND VALUATION

North Arrow

Q1-4 contains a unique population of valuable fancy orangey yellow diamonds

Orangey Yellow Diamonds:

- Certified* fancy orangey yellow diamonds desirable to the gem/jewelry trade
- > 1 billion years younger than non-coloured diamonds = different populations
- Indicated coarser distribution = more coloured stones in larger sizes

Two independent paths to potential diamond value upside (requires bigger bulk sample):

- 1. Coarser size frequency distribution (SFD)
- 2. Fancy orangey yellow diamonds are worth more

2018 WAY FORWARD

- **Mel** (July / August) Exploration **drilling** 6-8 targets. Discovery drilling and kimberlite delineation
- Loki Microdiamond results from EG05 and 465; Drilling priority targets including 853 (July / August)
- LDG JV \$2.8M exploration drilling program (ongoing)
- **Naujaat** Permitting road to Q1-4; **microdiamond results**; delineation **drilling** ahead of revised geological model & resource update; planning, permitting & costing 5-10,000t bulk sample







DIAMOND DISCOVERIES: A CANADIAN LEADER

NAR: Canadian diamond sector's most active & successful explorer over the last 5 years

- Discovered two new kimberlite fields Mel in 2017 & Pikoo in 2013
- 465 first Lac de Gras kimberlite discovery in over 5 years
- One of Canada's largest under-evaluated diamond inventories at Naujaat's Q1-4 kimberlite (~26 million carats)
- 6 drill-ready (and fully permitted) diamond properties; including 4 that host known diamondiferous kimberlite Naujaat, Mel, Pikoo and Loki
- Drilling at least 4 of these 6 projects for 2018;
 - Mel July / August
 - Loki March & July
 - LDG March through July
 - Naujaat August / spring 2018
