We have been responsibly developing Canadian mineral resources in Nunavut for more than 12 years. We are currently operating the Meliadine mine and Meadowbank Complex (including the Amaruq mine) in Nunavut's Kivalliq region and, as of February 2nd 2021, have added the Hope Bay mine which we acquired from TMAC Resources.

HOPE BAY

HOPE BAY IS A COMBINATION OF:

- Substantial historical investment with support infrastructure in place
- Significant mineral reserve and mineral resource base
- Existing operations with strong future production and mineral reserve expansion potential
- Provides considerable exploration upside in Nunavut from an 80km greenstone belt with similar scale and scope to Meliadine

DEVELOPING THE LOCAL WORKFORCE

Agnico Eagle supports the Nunavummiut aspiration to build a better future for themselves and their children. A long-term goal we have for our Nunavut operations is to develop our people so that one day our mines will be operated and managed by Nunavummiut.

We have collaborated with local governments to create skill development, employment readiness and retention programs for our Inuit workforce. We offer several educational, training and skills development initiatives to encourage Inuit to improve their skills and employability status.

These include:

- Pre-Trade and Apprenticeship Programs
- Career Paths
- Trainee Programs

Agnico Eagle has committed to investing over **\$3.6 million** per year towards Inuit training and development.

→ In 2019 alone, we invested nearly \$8 million towards training and development for our Inuit workforce, which represents 24% of the Inuit payroll.



SUPPORTING LOCAL COMMUNITIES

Agnico Eagle is committed to the social and economic development of sustainable communities in the regions where we operate and to be an active member of our communities. In Nunavut, one of the ways we do this is by contributing to a variety of programs and organizations that enrich the lives of our neighbours, more specifically in the areas of:









In 2019, Agnico distributed **more than \$1.8 million** to the Kivalliq communities in donations and sponsorships, and in 2020, committed \$5 million towards funding for mental health support programs and the development of the future Mine Training Center in Rankin Inlet.

Helping our Kivalliq neighbours throughout the COVID-19 pandemic

More than \$1M in donations and support initiatives since the beginning of the pandemic:

- \rightarrow Food hampers to all Kivalliq households;
- → Hygiene supplies and protective equipment;
- → Country food and harvest support for caribou distribution;
- → Support for telecommunications;
- → Snow removal to provide access to cabins for self-isolation;
- → No-contact policy with local communities.
