Chamber Congratulates Mine Rescue Championship Participants

Yellowknife, NT (June 19, 2012) Mine Rescue Teams from the three northern Territories demonstrated their life saving and rescue skills in the 55th Annual Mine Rescue Competition held in Yellowknife last week.

Teams participating in this year's event represented the EKATI, Diavik, and Snap Lake diamond mines and the Cantung tungsten mine in the NWT; the Minto copper-gold mine from the Yukon; and the Meadowbank gold mine from Nunavut.

Mine rescue teams are a critical aspect of safety at our northern mines, and their members hone their skills continuously at their home mine sites. The Annual Mine Rescue Competition provides an opportunity for teams from often diverse and distant mines to get together in a friendly environment to tackle a variety of skill-demonstrating events. Some of the events are focused on underground operations, while others on surface mines. Ekati was the only mine that sent teams for both. The top awards are the *Overall Surface* and *Overall Underground*, won by Ekati and Diavik respectively.
